

Privacy policy

1. The privacy and confidentiality of the Sender's personal and business data is very important to us. We are committed to protecting your personal data. Below is a summary of how Strifor LLC collects, uses, communicates and discloses and makes use on the information gathered. Information will be collected by lawful and fair means and where appropriate, with the knowledge or consent of the Sender. It also details your rights in respect of our processing of your personal information and how you may exercise them. Please take the time to read and understand this policy. Data that is collected via the usage of the Service is stored in a secured data base. It is used for the sole purpose of providing for the Service by Strifor LLC. We may make changes to this Notice from time to time and it is important that you check this Notice for any updates. Any personal information we hold will be governed by the current privacy notice at the given time. If we make changes we consider to be important, we will communicate them to you. By accessing the website at www.strifor.org, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms of service, all applicable laws and regulations, and agree that you are responsible for compliance with any applicable local laws. If you do not agree with any of these terms, you are prohibited from using or accessing this site.

2. The personal information we hold about you. The information about any rights that might be available to you in relation to the personal information we hold about you is set out below:

- a. Name, Surname and contact details
- b. Date of birth and gender
- c. Social media profiles
- d. Payment information
- e. Information about your income and wealth including details about your assets and liabilities, account balances, trading statements, tax and financial statements
- e. Profession and employment details
- f. Location data
- g. Knowledge and experience in trading, risk tolerance and risk profile
- h. IP address, device specifications and other information relating to your trading experience

i. Details of your visits to our website or our Apps including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data. We use "cookies" to collect information about you and your activity across our site. A cookie is a small piece of data that our website stores on your computer, and accesses each time you visit, so we can understand how you use our site. This helps us serve you content based on preferences you have specified. We also keep records of your trading behavior, including a record of:

- Products you trade with us
- Historical data about the trades and investments you have made, including the amount invested
- Your preference for certain types of products and services

We are required by law to identify you if you are opening a new account or adding a new signatory to an existing account. Anti-money laundering laws require us to sight and record details of certain documents (i.e. photographic and non-photographic documents) to meet the standards, set under those laws. Identification documentation, as required under anti-money laundering legislation or other legislation relevant to the services we provide to you includes: (a) passport; (b) driver's licence; (c) national identity card (if applicable); (d) utility bills; (e) trust deed (if applicable); (f) a credit check on the individual; or (g) other information we consider necessary to our functions and activities.

3. How to use your personal data. Under the Data Protection Legislation, we must always have a lawful basis for using personal data. The following table describes how we will use your personal data, and our lawful bases for doing so:

- a. Supplying our products and services to you. For the performance of our contract with you or to take steps at your request before entering into a contract

- b. Managing payments for our products and services. For our legitimate interests or those of a third party, ie to minimize fraud that could be damaging for us and for you.
- c. Personalizing and tailoring our products and services for you. For our legitimate interests or those of a third party, i.e. to be as efficient as we can so we can deliver the best service for you at the best price.
- d. To prevent and detect fraud against you. To comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.
- e. Communicating with you. To comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.
- f. Supplying you with information by email and/or post or text messages that you have opted in to you may optout at any time by sending an email to: or an SMS to: or clicking on the option on our website to opt out. To comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.
- g. Checking your information against sanction screening list. To comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.

We may use an information to understand who our visitors are, how they use our services, and how we may improve their experience of our website in future. We do not disclose the specifics of this information publicly, but may share aggregated and anonymized versions of this information, for example, in website and customer usage trend reports.

The personal information we collect is stored and processed in , or where we or our partners, affiliates and third-party providers maintain facilities. We only transfer data within jurisdictions subject to data protection laws that reflect our commitment to protecting the privacy of our users.

We only retain personal information for as long as necessary to provide a service, or to improve our services in future. While we retain this data, we will protect it within commercially acceptable means to prevent loss and theft, as well as unauthorized access, disclosure, copying, use or modification. That said, we advise that no method of electronic transmission or storage is 100% secure, and cannot guarantee absolute data security.

If you request your personal information be deleted, or where your personal information becomes no longer relevant to our operations, we will erase it from our system within a reasonable timeframe.

4. Who may we disclose personal information to? As part of using your personal information for the purposes set out above, we may disclose your information to:

- third party apps providers when you use our apps, communication systems and trading platforms which are provided to us by third parties;
- service providers and specialist advisers who have been contracted to provide us with services such as administrative, IT, analytics and online marketing optimization, financial, regulatory, compliance, insurance, research or other services;
- introducing brokers and affiliates with whom we have a mutual relationship;
- Payment service providers and banks processing your transactions;
- auditors or contractors or other advisers auditing, assisting with or advising on any of our business purposes;
- courts, tribunals and applicable regulatory authorities as agreed or authorised by law or our agreement with you
- government bodies and law enforcement agencies where required by law and in response to other legal and regulatory requests;
- any third-party where such disclosure is required in order to enforce or apply our Terms and Conditions of Service or other relevant agreements;
- anyone authorized by you.

We do not otherwise share or supply personal information to third parties. We do not sell or rent your personal information to marketers or third parties. But we may send informational or promotional messages on behalf of certain partners or advertisers to you via browser enabled notifications or email.

5. We will keep your personal information while you have an account with us or we are providing products and services to you. Thereafter, we will keep your personal information for as long as is necessary:

- to respond to any questions, complaints or claims made by you or on your behalf;
- to show that we treated you fairly;
- to keep records required by law.

We will not retain your personal information for longer than necessary for the purposes set out in this policy. Different retention periods apply for different types of personal information.

6. Management of personal information. We are committed to safeguarding and protecting personal data and will implement and maintain appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to protect any personal data provided to us from accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure of, or access to personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.

7. Changes to this policy At our discretion, we may change our privacy policy to reflect current acceptable practices. We will take reasonable steps to let users know about changes via our website. Your continued use of this site after any changes to this policy will be regarded as acceptance of our practices around privacy and personal information.

8. Your rights and responsibilities As our user, you have the right to be informed about how your data is collected and used. You are entitled to know what data we collect about you, and how it is processed. You are entitled to correct and update any personal information about you, and to request this information be deleted. You may amend your account information at any time, using the tools provided in your account control panel. You are entitled to restrict or object to our use of your data, while retaining the right to use your personal information for your own purposes. You have the right to opt out of data about you being used in decisions based solely on automated processing. All Cookies used by and on our website and applications are used in accordance with the current Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 ("Cookie Law") Before Cookies are placed on your computer or device, you will be shown a prompt requesting your consent to set those Cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of Cookies you are enabling us to provide the best possible experience and service to you. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of Cookies; however certain features of our website and applications may not function fully or as intended.

Certain features of our website and applications depend on Cookies to function. Cookie Law deems these Cookies to be "strictly necessary". Your consent will not be sought to place these Cookies, but it is still important that you are aware of them.
